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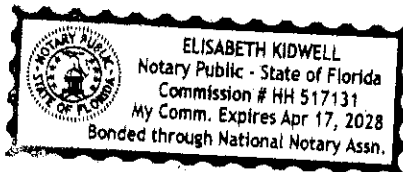

Lifelong friends navigate life on PGA Tour

Wednesday steak night has become a tradition unlike any other for PGA Tour pro Ryan Gerard and caddie Alex Ritthamel.

It began early this season when Ritthamel, who caddies for Ben Griffin, stayed at Gerard's home during the Cognizant Classic in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida.

"Ever since that event, either Ben or I has basically finished top-10 every week that we've done it, so we kind of kept it going just out of superstition," Gerard said.

That includes in New Orleans, where Griffin tasted victory on the PGA Tour for the first time in the team event with Andrew Novak, and Dallas, where he won individually. Just two weeks ago, it was Gerard's turn to notch his maiden PGA Tour title. Not too shabby for teammates at University of North Carolina who are enjoying two of the most notable breakout seasons this year.

"I think I'd like a little credit for making Alex well fed," Gerard said.

Who picks up the tab for dinner is determined by who makes more money in a given week. Each time Griffin won, Ritthamel ended up digging into his back pocket for his wallet to pay for dinner. It almost happened a third time at the Memorial but Scottie Scheffler is a force to be reckoned with and successfully defended his title.

"I was a little bit bummed at Memorial this year when you didn't close the deal," Gerard told Griffin, "because I made like \$4,000 more than him that week, so then I was on the hook for dinner the next week. Yeah, you know, try and win Memorial next year."

First things first and that is trying to win this week's Wyndham Championship, the final regular-season event of the FedExCup. Gerard started with a 2-under 68 at Sedgefield Country Club in Greensboro, North Carolina, on Thursday, July 31, and will have some work cut out to catch early leader Joel Dahmen, who birdied his final three

holes en route to a sizzling 9-under 61.

"I don't know if you ever see 61 coming, but I saw good golf coming," said Dahmen, who needs no worse than a two-way T-2 to improve into the top 70 in the season-long points race and qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs.

Sweden's Alex Noren, who needs to win to make the Playoffs, is a stroke back after a 62. Cameron Young, the Wake Forest University product who birdied his last five holes on the front nine; defending champion Aaron Rai, who is attempting to become the first defending champion of the Wyndham Championship to repeat since Sam Snead in 1956; and Colombia's Nico Echavarria all shot 7-under 63. Jordan Spieth and Adam Scott, who needs no worse than a two-way T-3 to make the Playoffs, are off to fast starts with 65s.

Gerard's dinner at least will taste better after finishing with a birdie. Steak may not necessarily be on the menu but Gerard said he'd happily buy Griffin's dinner for his wise counsel as Gerard debated flying to Northern Ireland, where he was second alternate for the British Open at Royal Portrush. Griffin

told him that he already was in the Barracuda Championship and to go there and win the thing. Gerard did just that and so Griffin is waiting for Gerard to give him his cut of his winnings.

But Gerard happily will buy Griffin's dinner for his wise counsel as Gerard debated flying to Northern Ireland, where he was second alternate for the British Open at Royal Portrush. Griffin told him that he already was in the Barracuda Championship, which was held in Truckee, California, and to go there and win the thing. Gerard did just that and so Griffin is waiting for Gerard to give him his cut of his winnings.

"Just 50% of his earnings is all," Griffin joked. "I've been looking on Zelle and Wells Fargo and Merrill accounts, nothing's hit yet."

"If he's so inclined, I will treat him to dinner on a Wednesday night of his choosing," Gerard promised.

These two friends, who were raised little more than an hour apart from each other, first played a junior event together at University of North Carolina's Finley Golf Course when Gerard was 9 or 10, Griffin about 12. They became fast

friends, even if Griffin gave him a hard time when Gerard was a freshman at UNC.

"When you get out here and you have like one of your best friends playing practice rounds with you all the time and kind of rooting for you, it was awesome seeing him win multiple times early this year, and inspirational," Gerard said. "I can't let him get too far ahead of me in the win column, so we've got to rein it in here a little bit. Just to see what he's done all season has been awesome and I hope he continues doing it, and if he continues doing it, I'm going to keep on his heels pushing him."

Griffin took a job selling insurance for a short time before resuming his pro golf aspirations. Gerard witnessed how hard Griffin worked on 100 degree days in the summer to get ready for Q-School.

"Second chances are rare, and when you get them you want to take advantage of them as you can," Gerard said.

Gerard can relate. When he got his latest chance to be in the trophy hunt, he recalled advice from UNC men's basketball coach Roy Williams, who texts Gerard every couple of weeks with words of encouragement. That included reminding him that legendary Tar Heels men's basketball coach Dean Smith made it to four Final Fours before he finally got to cut down the nets. Gerard kept his cool to the end in claiming his first PGA Tour title at the Barracuda.

"It's something that you work your entire life for. You never want to get ahead of yourself. You never want to feel like you put the cart before the horse and you let it slip away from you," he said. "But walking up knowing that you were going to win a PGA Tour event and I've spent hours and hours and hours on driving ranges and putting greens and golf courses and on airplanes since I was 5, 6 years old with a goal to win, kind of seeing all those moments kind of flash before you to end up culminating in a really special goal with a lot of people that have helped me along the way, it was pretty special."

Worthy of a Wednesday night steak dinner.

Pitchers, Suárez key stars moved before closing time

Kyle Finnegan trade grades

Detroit Tigers receive Kyle Finnegan; Washington Nationals receive RHP Josh Randall, RHP R.J. Sale

Tigers grade: B+ Finnegan isn't Mason Miller or Jhoan Duran or Ryan Helsley, but the 33-year-old is a great addition to Detroit's bullpen as a veteran with ninth-inning experience, saving 86 games over the past three seasons for the middling Nationals. An All-Star in 2024, Finnegan has only given up three home runs in 34 games this season and could take some save chances from Will Vest, who has 2.53 ERA in 16 saves for the Tigers in 2025.

Nationals grade: B The least-sexy closer on the market, Finnegan netted the Nationals a pair of pitchers with Randall ranking as Detroit's No. 15 prospect, according to MLB.com.

Mason Miller trade grades

San Diego Padres receive RHP Mason Miller, LHP JP Sears; Athletics receive SS Leo De Vries, RHP Braden Nett, RHP Henry Báez and RHP Eduarniel Nuñez

Padres grade: B It's quite a coup get-

ting both the game's most dominant closer and a guy with four years of club control remaining after this season. Miller, 26, is generally untouchable in the ninth inning and in two seasons as A's closer has nailed down 48 of 54 save opportunities, an 89% conversion rate on par with Hall of Famers Trevor Hoffman and Mariano Rivera.

The cost? It's huge. De Vries is the most significant international signing the Padres have had this decade, no small honor, and he's consistently been challenged – and succeeded – at levels where the average player is four to five years older than him. Put simply: Not many 17-year-olds flash power and speed in stateside A ball and go on to the Arizona Fall League, as De Vries did in 2024.

While Miller's controllable years mean the Padres can flip him in future seasons for either immediate help or to galvanize their system, it still stings to trade a potential (likely?) franchise player for a reliever.

Athletics grade: A The deal begs one dark question: Will any of their young stars make it to Las Vegas, should they ever complete their ballpark there? It's yet another step back at the big-league level for the A's in a five-year cycle of utter desiccation that hastened their

move from Oakland.

Paul Sewald trade grades

Detroit Tigers receive RHP Paul Sewald; Cleveland Guardians receive player to be named later.

Tigers grade: B+ Sewald is injured and expected to return in September, so this is a move the Tigers are making for October. The 35-year-old had a 4.70 ERA in 18 games this season, but his underlying numbers look better than that with a 4.07 FIP, 1.174 WHIP and 4.5 strikeouts per walk.

Guardians grade: B PTBNL for an injured reliever? Why not.

Eugenio Suárez trade grades

Seattle Mariners receive 3B Eugenio Suarez; Arizona Diamondbacks receive 1B Tyler Locklear, RHP Juan Burgos and RHP Hunter Cranton.

Mariners grade: B+ They got the top hitter available and it's telling that the Mariners liked Suárez enough to bring him back after less than two years apart – despite his struggles in Seattle. Mariners third basemen have totaled just five home runs and 35 RBIs this season.

Diamondbacks grade: B+ Pretty

good return, plucking three of Seattle's top 20 prospects in Locklear (No. 9), Cranton (16) and Burgos (17). Locklear, 24, will likely find himself getting a run-out in Arizona's lineup sooner rather than later. The first baseman made his big-league debut last season and has nothing left to prove in the minors (.316/.401/.552, 19 HR, 82 RBIs in Class AAA).

Jhoan Duran trade grades

Philadelphia Phillies receive RHP Jhoan Duran; Minnesota Twins receive C Eduardo Tait, RHP Mick Abel

Phillies grade: A Dave Dombrowski seized on his opportunity to get 2½ years of one of the best relievers in baseball in exchange for just a pair of prospects. It's a huge addition for the Phillies, with Duran presumably assuming the ninth-inning role and taking a ton of pressure off the club's other high-leverage guys. Philadelphia has the 27-year-old flamethrower under team control through 2027.

Twins grade: C- It's hard to believe that this is the best return the Twins could have gotten for the most desirable reliever on the market. That said, Tait is only 18 and rising fast on prospect boards, while Abel is a good candidate for a post-hype bounce back.

‘The Colonel and the King’ divulges big Elvis revelations

What if we got it wrong about Colonel Tom Parker?

That’s the provocative question raised by music historian Peter Guralnick’s latest book, “The Colonel and the King” (Little, Brown, 624 pp., out now), which examines Parker’s reputational arc from visionary to villain.

“His motivations were almost completely misunderstood,” says Guralnick of Elvis Presley’s wheeling and dealing manager, who receives an overdue reassessment in the new biography. “When I call their partnership a partnership of equals, I think it really was.”

For Parker, “it was love at first sight. The colonel was a believer in show business. That was his one article of belief. And Elvis was the greatest entertainer he’d ever seen. He knew it the moment he saw him.”

Guralnick realizes it’s a reappraisal many aren’t willing to undertake, and “I’m not trying to paint the colonel as a saint,” he says. “I would be glad to have him as my manager, but at the same time, I would want to look closely at what I was agreeing to.”

The book, which traces the colonel’s life from his secretive childhood in Holland to his death in 1997, takes a deep dive into their productive partnership. (Elvis fans may be surprised that touchstones like the courting of Priscilla Presley and the making of the ‘68 Comeback Special are mentioned only in passing, but this is, after all, Parker’s story.) In keeping with the characteristic level of detail that the faithful have come to expect from Guralnick’s previous Presley biographies (“Last Train to Memphis,” “Careless Love”), nearly half the book is turned over to Parker’s illuminating letters.

These are among the biography’s biggest revelations:

Parker repeatedly ran away from home and claimed to have been adopted multiple times

Parker spun a myth about his upbringing in West Virginia that endured for decades. In reality, he was born Andreas Cornelis van Kuijk in Holland and came to America as an underage stow-

away. He presented himself as an orphan and would ingratiate himself with families and then disappear, joining circuses, carnivals and the U.S. Army on his way to careers as a Humane Society director and a music promoter.

Guralnick cautions against taking Parker’s explanation of his origins too literally. “He loved to tell that story, and you can judge from that his psychology. But he was someone who in some ways felt so abandoned and alienated from the world in which he grew up. He was abused by his father. But I don’t think that was the real story. Something traumatic happened, and he carried that with him all of his life.”

Elvis’ high-stakes contracts were often handshake deals that Tom Parker didn’t have in writing

Elvis’ contracts, specifically with RCA, were often verbal agreements.

“One of the things that necessitated everything not being written down was the favored-nation clause, which every big star had. Any big employer can understand this,” Guralnick says. “You say to me, I’ll pay you \$1,000 more. But if you have contracts with other people, there may be a dozen other people, so it’s not just my \$1,000, it’s going to cost you \$12,000 more.”

The colonel worked those backdoor deals to Presley’s advantage, Guralnick notes. In November 1955, Elvis was paying back his RCA advance out of his royalties. Eleven months later, Elvis had a million-dollar contract (the equivalent of \$10 million today).

“That’s a pretty good turnaround,” Guralnick says.

“(Parker) always articulated the belief that a deal was no good unless it was to the benefit of both parties.”

Elvis never toured internationally, but mostly because he couldn’t cross borders with his drugs, guns

Presley’s friends in the Memphis Mafia were convinced that Elvis wanted to tour the world and blamed Parker’s fear of deportation. But the colonel worried that security would be a concern.

“Everybody thought he meant you can’t get armed guards to protect Elvis from the crowds,” Guralnick says. “That

wasn’t what he meant at all – he meant the security to keep Elvis from getting busted. Who was going to carry the drugs? Who was going to carry the guns?”

Elvis and Parker both considered parting ways, but their respective addictions kept them together

In addition to the infamous 1973 incident at the Hilton Hotel in Vegas, in which Elvis lashed out at Parker from the stage, and they (temporarily) fired each other, there were other instances when they attempted to split. But the colonel had developed a gambling addiction to go along with Elvis’ drug dependency.

“Each of them was aware of the other’s addiction, the other’s failures, and neither one of them was going to bring up the other’s failure for fear that the other would then bring up his own. And so they were stuck,” Guralnick says.

“The colonel became in a sense not a tragic figure, because he was a life force overall, so full of vitality and creativity.

But I came to see those last years with Elvis as a linked tragedy, in which each of them has their own addiction, and I just didn’t see that before.”

Elvis may have known Parker was an undocumented immigrant – and kept it a secret

In 1960, Parker’s family in Holland recognized him in a photo with Elvis. He reluctantly agreed to bring his brother Ad to the United States for a visit in 1961 and apparently introduced him to Elvis, who might reasonably have wondered why his American manager’s sibling spoke virtually no English.

Many in Elvis’ entourage doubted that the meeting happened, “because Elvis could not keep a secret. He was the worst in the world at keeping a secret, and this was the biggest secret of all,” Guralnick says.

The colonel may have presented Ad simply as someone he knew from the carnival or circus. “But I’d like to think he introduced him as his brother and that Elvis knew.”
